WHEREAS Henry Sage and Miss F.Sage of Bridge Farm in the Parish of Woodbury Salterton Devon being desirous of dissolving the partnership existing between them and Whereas by an appointment dated the 27 day of May 1925, I the said James Alfred Cornish was duly appointed to value the Live and Dead Farming Stock Tenant-Right Interest and all other matters in connection with the aforesaid Farm as between them NOW I the said James Alfred Cornish having taken upon myself the burden of the said reference and having been over and inspected the said Farm on the 27 day of May 1925 and valued the various items as set forth in the Schedule hereto and having heard examined and considered the witnesses and evidence adduced to me concerning the same do hereby award as follows:-

I AWARD AND DETERMINE that there is due to the said Miss F.Sage from the said Henry Sage the sum of One thousand two hundred and ten pounds six shillings and one penny (£1210 :6:1) in full settlement of her share of the items mentioned in the first part of the within written Schedule after making due allowance for the items contained in the second part thereof and I further award that the costs of this my award shall be paid by the said Henry Sage and Miss F.Sage in equal parts.
