I Joseph Phillips of Woodbury Salterton in the County of Devon do solemnly and sincerely declare that no suit in Equity and that no Action at Law is pending against me, that no judgment decree or Order at Law or in Equity has been recovered or made against me which is now in force or unsatisfied and that I am not liable for the payment of any Crown debts or any Annulity but that I am now seized in fee simple in possession of All those two Fields called "Waterford" and "Hospins Acre" situate in Woodbury Salterton aforesaid free and clear of all mortgages charges settlements liens incumbrances judgments lites pendentos or any other charge whatsoever. And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the provisions of an Act made and passed in the Session of Parliament of the fifth and sixth years of the reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth intituled "An Act to repeal an Act of the present Session of Parliament intituled "An Act for the more effectual abolition of Oaths and Affirmations taken and made in various departments of the State and to substitute declarations in lieu thereof and for the more entire suppression of voluntary and extra judicial Oaths and Affidavits and to make other provisions for the abolition of unnecessary Oaths."
