After our interview this morning there can remain no doubt on my own mind as to my course of action; & allow me to add that it is a source of satisfaction to me that my course of action in this matter is so plain. I at first admitted that I had not legal authority for erecting the new Heredos in the chancel. I am instructed that I was within legal bounds in restoring the sedilia & the niche forming a piscina; you are content for yourselves & for others that the new Heredos if it be somewhat lowered in height should remain as well as the lowered graduated sill of the South window forming sedilia. If I will cover over the niche forming a piscina with freestone, the

projecting edge of the same I remain to serve as a credence table. I very readily say, yes, to these terms, & should regard myself as being unmindful of the meeting feeling of others. If I hesitated on the point. You in behalf of yourselves & others give up some points & I cannot do less than follow your example. The slab on which the records rest shall not be used for placing thereon a morable cross unless with the concurrence of Churchwardens or vestry.

If at any future time there may be any desire on the part of myself or others to make any further alterations in the chancel or in any portion of the church, such alterations shall not be commenced without the concurrence of the churchwardens.

Allow me to thank you for the way in which you conducted the interview this morning. & to express a hope that that which at first seemed likely to be a cause of estrangement may in the end turn out to be a means of kinder feeling & greater concord.
